Applicants should indicate in proposals as well as in this log-frame how the dialogue outcomes will be communicated and demonstrated to policy target groups as well as the wider public.

Definitions:

“Impact” means the primary and secondary, long term effects produced by the Action.

“Outcome” means the likely or achieved short-term and medium-term effects of an Action’s outputs.

“Output” means the products, capital goods and services which result from an Action’s activities.

“Indicator” is the quantitative/qualitative factor or variable that provides a simple and reliable means to measure the achievement of the Results of an Action.
